
The Moyles

As the Lord willed Marsh and Tuula Moyle were sent out by Mount Road Baptist Church in 1983 and have worked for most of that time in Central and Eastern Europe. Marsh met Tuula, who is from Finland, in Vienna where they lived and travelled into Central Europe to support the Church from 1975 to 1992. They then moved to Slovakia after the fall of Communism.

In 2008 they moved back to the United Kingdom and now live in Greatham in Hampshire. They work and have a study at L'Abri (England) where they are "missionaries-in-residence". This involves teaching and tutoring people who are interested in learning more about the Christian faith and allow them to invite people from Central Europe for longer periods of study and reflection. Often Marshall teaches in Russia and Ukraine.

They started a charity called CityGate and in the 1990's set up several publishing houses in Central Europe and Russia. They continue to run what are known as Gospel in Society conferences where young people learn how their work and daily life are centred on the calling of Christ. For many years in Slovakia they ran a learning community where people could come to ask questions about the Christian faith.



They have published materials to help people understand the meaning of the Gospel and have carried out research over the years.
